NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS
FOR
WAYNE MAKIN ELECTRICAL BACKBONE PROJECT

The City of NORCO, as AGENCY, invites sealed bids for the above stated project and will receive such bids in the offices of the City Clerk up to the hour of **10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 13, 2017**, at which time, or as soon thereafter as practicable, they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and incidentals required for the above stated project as set forth in the Specifications, Drawings, and Contract Documents therefore, and to perform all work in the manner and time prescribed therein. The general items of work to be done hereunder consist of the construction and installation of new electrical backbone as specified by the Specifications, Standards and drawings as described herewith.

There are 45 working days allowed to complete this project including design. Liquidated damages shall be assessed at \$500.00 per working day.

Note, all RFI's must be in writing and sent to James Corns at JCA Engineering. **If copies of the Specifications and Contract Documents are obtained from outside sources, it is the responsibility of the Contractor to obtain copies of all addendums prior to the bidding deadline.**

Any Contract entered into pursuant to this notice will incorporate the provisions of the State Labor Code. Compliance with the prevailing rates of wages, apprenticeship employment standards, and Contractor registration program established by the State of California Director of Industrial Relations will be required. Affirmative action to ensure against discrimination in employment practices on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, sex, or religion will be also required.

Bids must be prepared on the approved proposal forms in conformance with the Instructions to Bidders and submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked on the outside:

“SEALED BID FOR WAYNE MAKIN ELECTRICAL BACKBONE PROJECT - DO NOT OPEN WITH REGULAR MAIL.”

Each bidder is hereby notified of a mandatory pre-bid meeting on Wednesday, August 23, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. Bidders not attending this meeting will be disqualified as non-responsive. The location of the pre-bid meeting will be at Wayne Makin Sports Complex, 3364 Western Ave, Norco. Enter the north gate and park in the parking lot at the north end of the complex. Proposals by Bidders that do not attend this mandatory pre-bid meeting will not be considered.

At the time of Contract award, the prime contractor must possess a C-10 license for electrical work and a C-7 for communication (telephone/data) to perform the work.
