**FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

1. **What are the costs and what is included with Registration?**
  - Registration Fees: residents \$95, non-residents \$100.
  - Registration includes a jersey and participation trophy. Pictures are available at an additional cost.
2. **Where are practices and games held?**
  - Practices and Games are held at Riley Gym: [3950 Acacia Avenue, Norco, CA 92860](https://www.google.com/maps/place/3950+Acacia+Avenue,+Norco,+CA+92860)
3. **When are practices and games scheduled?**
  - Practices are scheduled once a week, for one hour. Days and Times depend on the Coach that your child is placed on.
  - Games are scheduled 1-2 times per week. Traditionally, games are scheduled primarily on Saturdays with occasional weeknights throughout the season.
4. **Does my child have to attend the Skills Rating?**
  - It is highly recommended that all participants attend the Skills Rating. Coaches will be able to evaluate all Players prior to the Draft. Please refer to the front page for important 'Skills Rating' dates. If your child does not attend, he/she will be a blind lottery pick.
  - Pee Wee and Instructional does **NOT** require a Skills Rating Assessment.
5. **Where can I find the game schedule?**

6. **How long is the season?**
  - Summer season will be approximately 8 weeks long, with 8-10 regular season games; playoffs to follow right after for Divisional leagues ONLY.
7. **It is my child's first year playing. Can he/she play down a Division?**
  - Unfortunately, your child can NOT play down a division. Our Youth Basketball League is a Recreation League, so it is a great way for your child to learn and begin playing.
8. **Can my child play in more than one Division?**
  - Yes. Your child can play in the age appropriate division and play up a division as well.
9. **When will I hear from a Coach regarding first practice?**
  - Pee Wee, Instructional, Divisional Team Rosters and practice schedule will be published on [Team Sideline](http://www.TeamSideline.com) on the Saturday, May 11<sup>th</sup>.
  - **Please do not call Parks and Rec asking which team your child is on. We ask that you wait until the Team Rosters are published online. ☺**
  - Coaches will contact you directly to inform you when your first team practice and answer any questions.
