Who we Service:

- **Family Caregivers:** Informal caregivers caring for a loved one who is 18 years and older with an organic brain impairment or caring for a senior over the age of 60.
- Seniors 60 years and older
- Riverside, San Bernardino, Inyo, and Mono County residents

Our Virtual Services:

- **Information and Referral:** Appropriate referrals and information as needed.
- **Family Consultation:** Virtual or phone assessment to evaluate caregiver needs.
- **Short-term Counseling:** 6-10 sessions via virtual setting.
- **Support Groups:** Family Caregiver support groups via virtual or phone meetings.
- **Educational Workshops:** Virtual classes on various topics.
- **PEARLS:** Program to encourage active and rewarding lives for seniors in Riverside County through virtual sessions.
- * **Respite Care:** Break from caregiving if caregiver is overwhelmed, depressed, etc. is still available in the home.
