The City of Norco is accepting applications to fill two (2) vacancies on the Historic Preservation Commission.

Any resident of the City of Norco may serve on a City commission. No member is selected on the basis of representing a specific business, district, organization, or cause. Requirements to serve on the Commission are as follows:

Service on City Commissions is a 4-year term: You must be a permanent resident of Norco, 21 years of age, a citizen of the U.S., take the oath of office, and never convicted of a felony.

Historic Preservation Commission members shall be persons who, as a result of their education, training, knowledge, and experience are qualified to analyze and interpret architectural and site planning information, including but not limited to, licensed landscape architects and architects, urban planners, engineers, and licensed general contractors. At least two of the members shall have professional experience in urban planning, architectural history or historic preservation, archeology, American studies, cultural geography, cultural anthropology and shall have general knowledge of architectural styles prevalent in the Historic Old Town of Norco. Please include your qualifications for this Commission on your application!

An appointment to a City commission is an honor and a responsibility. The City Council has confidence in the judgment and integrity of its appointees and relies on them for information and recommendations on specific matters. As advisors to the Council, commission members are expected to regularly attend meetings, understand their duties and roles, and work to contribute to the betterment of the community.
